TIMELY NOTIFICATION OF DIVORCES IMPERATIVE

It is mandatory that you report a divorce to the Welfare Fund (Ext. 589) immediately upon its completion. You will be instructed to submit a full copy of your divorce document. If your divorce document is not yet available from the court or municipal clerk, you will be required to complete a pre-printed affidavit. The Fund Office cannot accept your verbal notification; you must submit your divorce document or complete an affidavit for the divorce to be properly recorded. In order for COBRA coverage to be offered to the non-participant spouse it is essential that you report a divorce to the Fund Office immediately. If a divorce is not reported within 60 days COBRA coverage is not offered.

In addition, you are financially liable for the costs the Welfare Fund incurs due to your non-notification. Almost every month a member neglects to notify the Fund Office about a divorce and gets personally billed for the claim, insurance and other costs the Fund paid due to the member's negligence.

24/7 NURSELINE - HELP ANYTIME, ANYWHERE

Or can treatment wait until you get home to your primary care physician? Is this something you can handle with a few supplies from the drugstore? Or do you need to be seen at an urgent care center?

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EMPIRE'S OUT-OF-NETWORK REIMBURSEMENT SCHEDULE CHANGING AND ADDITIONAL SERVICES WILL REQUIRE PRE-AUTHORIZATION

As a result of a lawsuit filed by the New York State Attorney General against Ingenix, who produced two databases used by Empire to price out-of-network/non-participating medical claims, the Ingenix schedules will no longer be used after July 31, 2011. As of August 1st, Empire will be using the National Medicare Physician Fee Schedule (NMPFS). Empire, by agreement of the Trustees of each Welfare Fund, will use 330% of the NMPFS which mirrors the 70th percentile of the present Ingenix pricing format. Consequently, there will be no appreciable difference in the pricing structure in which out-of-network medical claims are processed and paid.

In addition, as of June 1, 2011 the following services will require pre-authorization from Empire's Medical Management Program :

- Air ambulance (scheduled)
- Diagnostics
 - Genetic testing for cancer susceptibility
- Outpatient treatments, including certain ambulatory surgical procedures
 - Endoscopic sinus surgery
 - Nasal surgery for the treatment of obstructive sleep apnea and/or migraine headaches (includes: excision of polyp(s), turbinate(s), ablation of turbinate(s), septoplasty, repair of vestibular stenosis)
 - Breast procedures including reconstructive surgery and implants (not including post-mastectomy breast reconstructive surgery)
 - Surgery for clinically severe obesity
 - Spinal cord stimulator surgery
 - Cochlear implant surgery

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RETIRED MEMBERS, SPOUSES & MEDICARE PART B

Whether you retire on a regular or disability pension you and your spouse must enroll in Medicare Part B as soon as you are eligible. You and your spouse will receive information regarding your eligibility directly from the federal government. Once either of you are eligible for Medicare Part B, your Welfare Fund coverage acts in a secondary role. If you or your spouse do not enroll in Part B when either of you are supposed to there will be no benefits.

Although it is discussed at the bi-annual Retirement Seminar, reviewed at great length at each individual pension interview, described in all retirement printed material, explained in your personalized Welfare Fund retirement letter and included in the Welfare Fund SPD benefit booklet with its own section, occasionally a member neglects to enroll.
